It's a pure pleasure to look at the animation of the retrograde seconds (and the tourbillon) on the front side! It also shows the ingenuity of SCHWARZ ETIENNE's engineers who develop/produce complicated components in order to measure the time and please the collectors. The calibre TSEPSR122.00 is 100% in-house and integrates several modules.

The back engravings with its tricky « juxtaposed image » offer a nice visual effect ! as much as the location of the sapphire window behind the tourbillon. Here we've a modern novelty and its quality (in terms of finishing & decoration) is very well done.
